We were informed by the Russian Kynological Federation (RKF) that their all-breed judge, Mr Revaz Khomasuridze, sadly passed away on April 11, 2021, at the far too early age of 58 years old.

Revaz was a dog show judge since 1979. His competence, expertise, knowledge and kindness made him appreciated from everyone in the dog world.

Revaz was an all-breed judge since 1995 and he occupied several key functions within RKF:

- RKF General Secretary in 1993—1999
- President of the RKF Breeding commission 1993–1999
- RKF President in 1999—2001
- RKF cynological counsellor in 2001—2015
- RKF Board member — from 2018
- Head of the RKF Standard commission — from 2018
- Head of the RKF Pedigree department — from 2018

Last but surely not least, on top of his brilliant judge career, Revaz was a very well-known worldwide breeder of top winning French Bulldogs with strong health and fabulous temperament, under the kennel name ***A'Vigdors***.
