FCI COMMISSION FOR SIGHTHOUND RACES

A) PRESENTATION

The Commission for Sighthound Races is one of the non-mandatory commissions of the FCI. The assignment of the commission is to represent, to organize and to take care of the good functioning of the Sighthound races and coursing.

The Commission for Sighthound Races is made up of delegates from countries which are a member of the FCI and want to have a representative in this commission. National Organisations which are interested can report this to the FCI General Assembly or to the FCI Secretariat.

To become effective, all decisions made in the commission, have to be approved by the FCI General Committee.

The Commission for Sighthound Races is led by a president and a secretary, chosen by the delegates of the commission.

The Commission for Sighthound Races makes and keeps up to date the “FCI Regulations for International Sighthound Races and Lure Coursing Events” and the “International Guidelines for Lure Coursing judges”.

The Commission for Sighthound Races also supervises Races and Coursings where the “CACIL” can be awarded and the “FCI International Race Champion Titles” (C.I.C. – International Race Champion and C.I.B.P. International Beauty and Performance Champion). The Commission for Sighthound Races allocates the World & European Races Championships and the European Coursing Championships to the FCI member countries.

B) MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS

The Commission for Sighthound Races meets usually once in a year. Minutes of the meeting are sent to the FCI Secretariat and to all delegates of the commission and then submitted to the approval of the delegates during the next meeting of the commission.
