Qualification and selection for the FCI-International Working Test for Retrievers (FCI-IWT)



## Art. 1 - ORGANISATION

The FCI International Working Test (FCI-IWT) will be organised according to the "FCI Rules for International Working Tests for Retrievers" on every year.

It is in the decision of the organising country how many official teams can represent a country.

The FCI delegates shall receive the invitation from the organising country and are responsible for informing the clubs and associations of their country, collecting the entries, ranking the dogs/teams according to their results and confirming the entry forms to the organising committee.

## Art. 2 – QUALIFICATION AND SELECTION

The applying teams shall be ranked based upon their results or in countries where a special selection test or other selection procedure is held, on the basis of the results obtained there.

The defending winning team of the last IWT has a fixed additional place to run at the following FCI-IWT.
